- The biggest cultural project in the history of Czech Republic
- Total budget around 68 mio EUR
 - 18,2 mio EUR for the soft operation
 - 48,7 mio EUR for capital investments infrastructure
- Around 0,8 mio EUR spent on candidacy [expected 3-5 mio EUR in Germany 2025]
- 22,4 mio EUR expenditures of visitors directly connected to the visit ECoC events
- 1,4 mio overall attendance on ECoC events
- 31% increase of overnight stays
- 25,8% increase of accommodated guests

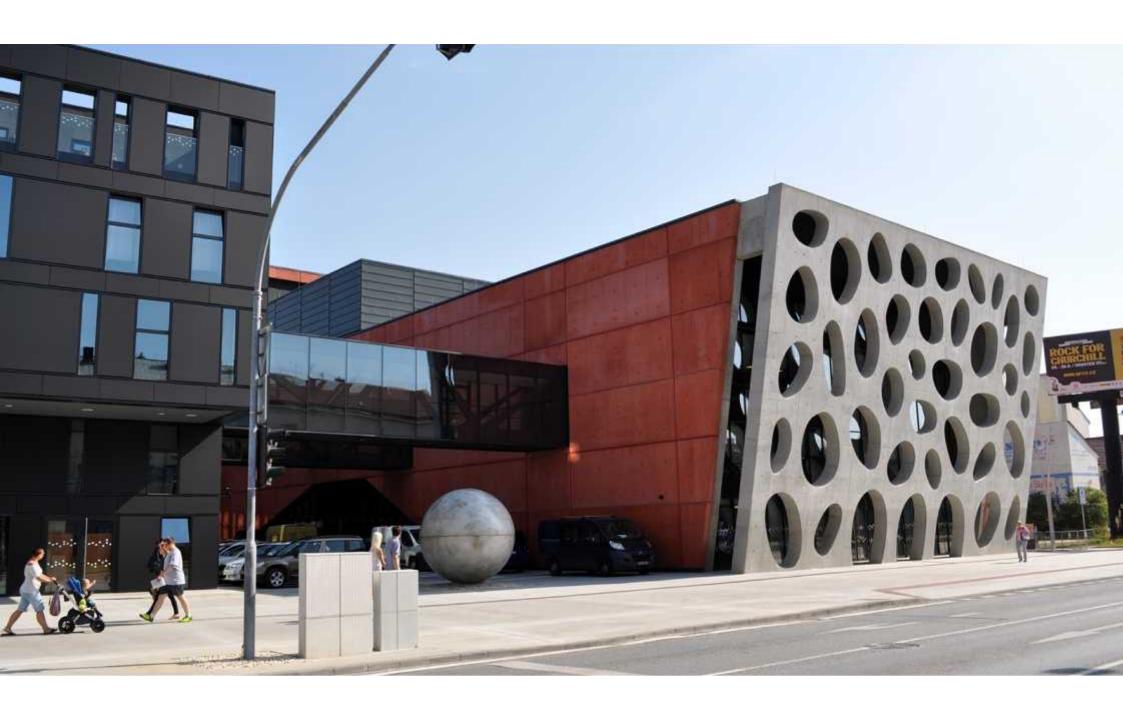

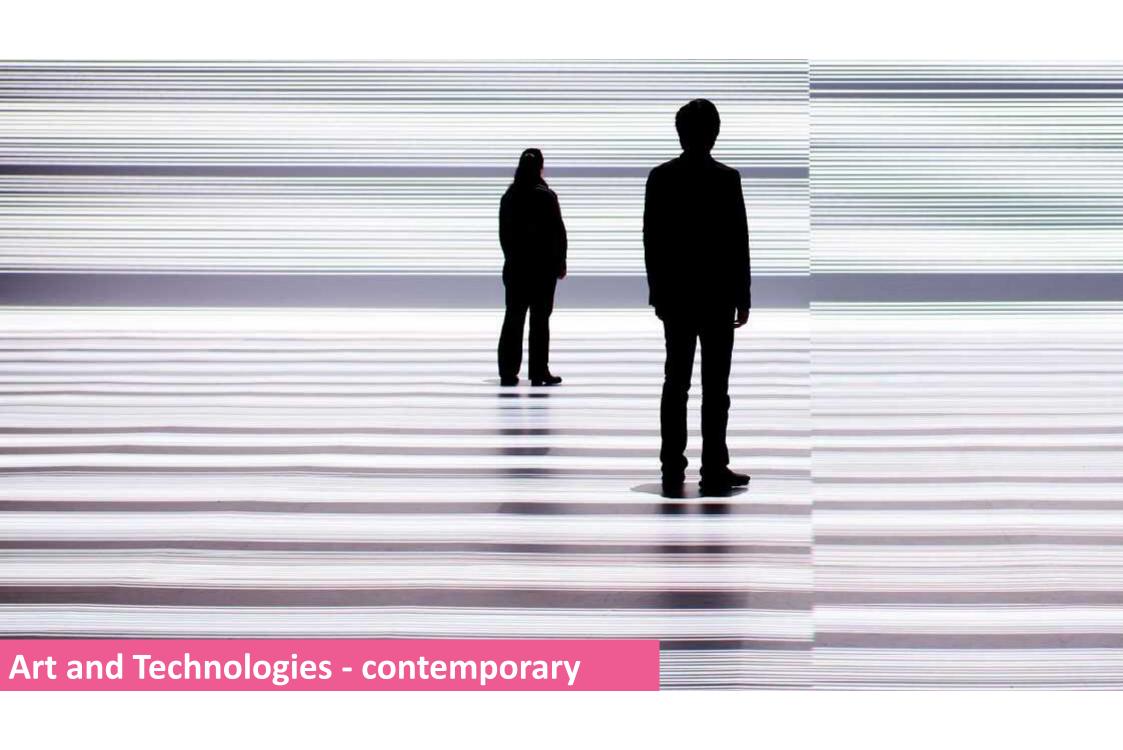

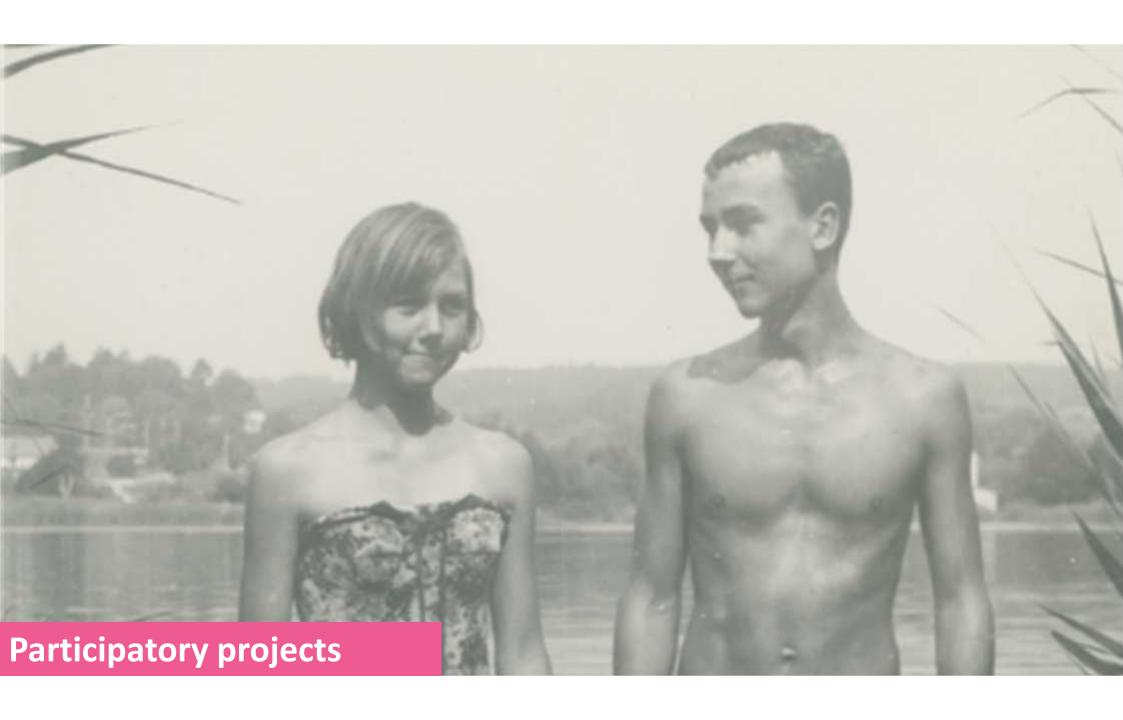
European dimension and networking
